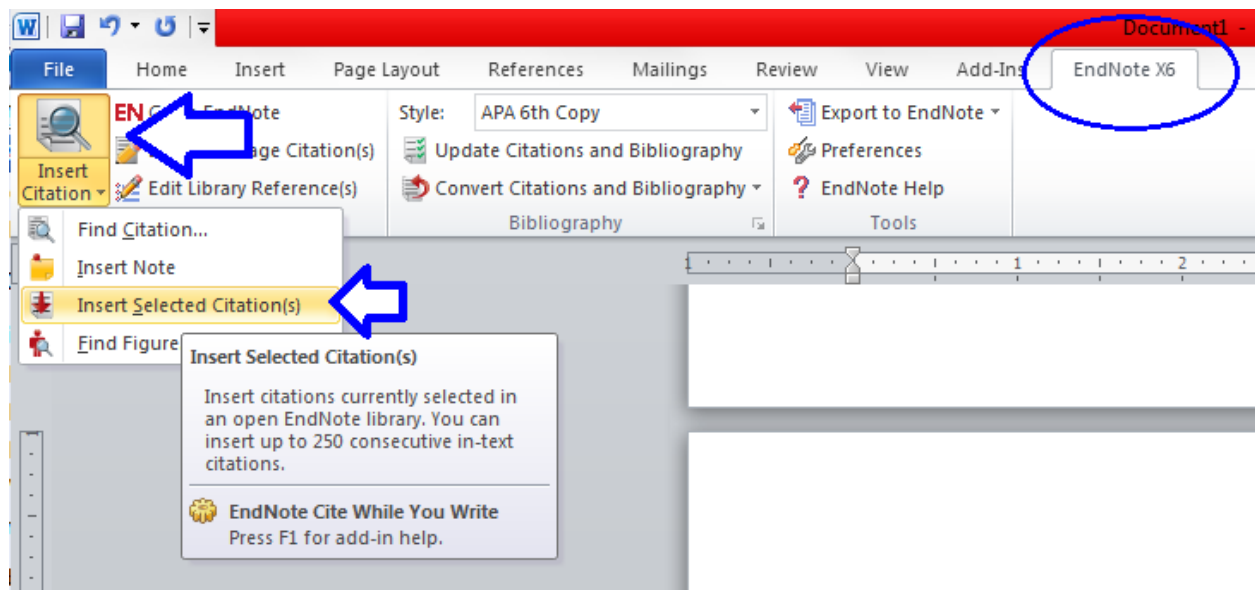
Insert citation from EndNote into MS-Word

EndNote X6 Tab → Insert Citation → Insert Selected citation(s)

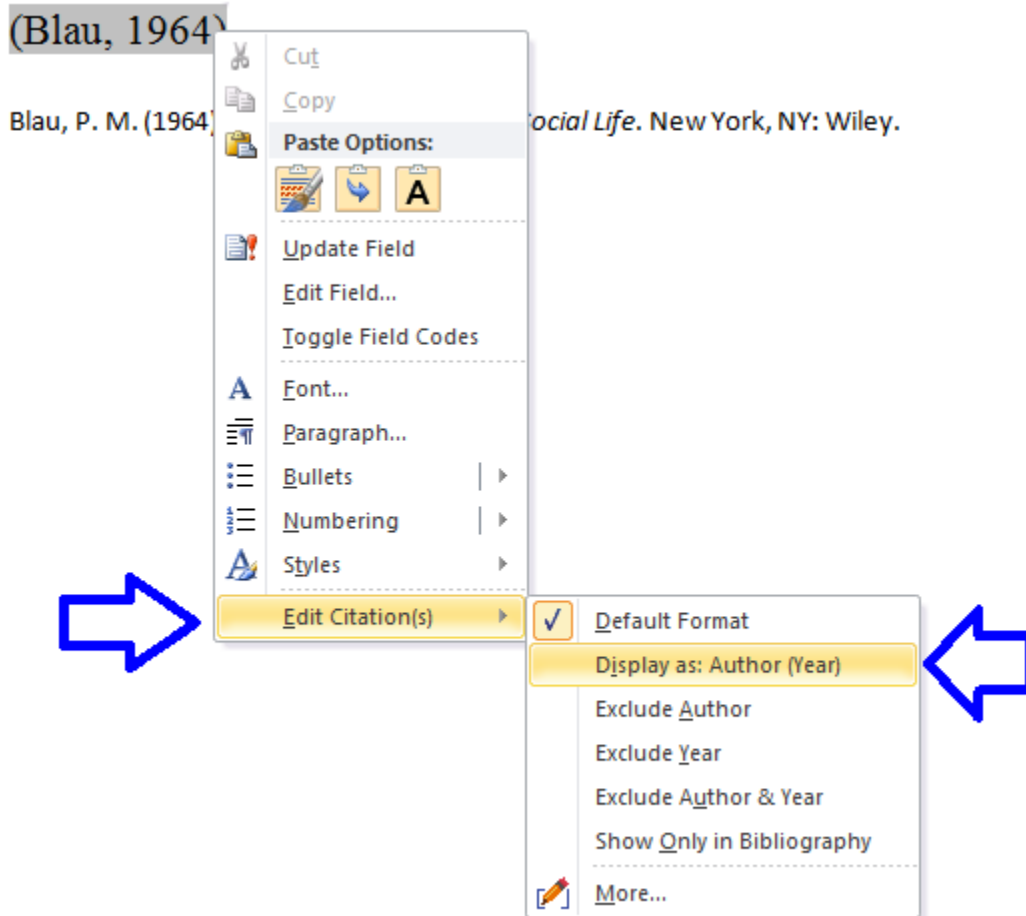


Change citation style from “(Author, year)” to “Author (year)”
